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## RPI RE-FLEX TPO MEMBRANE ROOFING CARE AND MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES

CONGRATULATIONS on your purchase of an R.P.I. Re-Flex TPO Membrane Roof. Your roof is a valuable asset which must be properly maintained to ensure it performs as designed.

1. Ensure that the *Re-Flex* Membrane is not exposed to liquids such as solvents, greases, oils, and petroleum products. These products will adversely affect the membrane.

NOTE: Should the Re-Flex Membrane come in contact with any of these substances, immediately clean the area with membrane cleaner.

- 2. Ensure that ponding water (defined as 1/8" deep standing water on any area of the roof forty-eight (48) hours after it stops raining) is not allowed on the roof. Ponding water is a detriment to any flat roof and cannot be allowed to persist.
- 3. Ensure that all drain areas and drains are cleaned on a regular basis. This will allow for proper water runoff and avoid overloading the roof with ponding water.
- **4.** Keep all counter flashing, metal work, drains, equipment, curbs and supports, and any other rooftop accessories functioning in conjunction with the roofing system properly maintained at all times. R.P.I. encourages an annual roof inspection program be arranged with your applicator.
- 5. If there is to be foot traffic on the roof for any reason, on a regular basis (30 days or less in frequency), contact your applicator before proceeding for the installation of protective walk way pads.
- **6.** Caution all tradesmen servicing roof equipment that you have a TPO Membrane roof, and they should proceed accordingly.
- 7. Should there be an addition to the building, requiring a tie-in to the R.P.I. Re-Flex TPO Membrane Roof, contact R.P.I. to ensure the tie-in is in accordance with R.P.I. specifications.

NOTE: Do not use asphalt based roof cement for installation or repair of Re-Flex TPO Membrane or flashing. Use only RPI Re-Flex TPO products.

R.P.I. believes the foregoing procedures will assist you, the building owner, in maintaining a watertight roof and in obtaining the maximum return on your investment in R.P.I.'s Re-Flex TPO Membrane Roof.
